



Outdoor Play Collection Terms & Conditions

General Use and Responsibility

The following Terms and Conditions apply to the use of the Outdoor Play Collection. The cardholder is responsible for ensuring proper usage and timely return of all borrowed materials. By borrowing any items, the cardholder agrees to pay applicable fees for any kits or components that are lost, missing, or damaged. All items and kit components must be returned in person to library staff at the end of the borrowing period. BPL's [Borrowing Policy](#) and [Fees & Charges Policy](#) apply when borrowing all library materials.

Safe Operation and Liability

Borrowed items may not be used unlawfully or in any manner that contravenes Library policies, rules, or regulations. Safe and supervised operation of play equipment is required at all times, and the borrower is accountable for ensuring that all equipment is used safely and appropriately. The Library accepts no liability for misuse of borrowed equipment, and any injury or damage arising from improper use is solely the responsibility of the borrower. Transportation of borrowed materials is exclusively the borrower's responsibility, this includes loading the equipment into a vehicle. The Library does not provide transportation assistance and assumes no liability for issues during transit. Items remain the borrower's responsibility until they are returned and removed from the cardholder's account.

Usage Restrictions and Eligibility

The Outdoor Play collection is available to BPL cardholders in good standing (some restrictions may apply based on card type). Children and young adults have access to all materials in the library, including the Outdoor Play collection. As with other library materials, responsibility for monitoring a child's access and use of these items rests with parents and guardians.

Equipment Use and Returns

Equipment must be used exclusively for its intended purposes, and all instructions provided by library staff must be carefully followed. All borrowed items must be returned in the same condition as issued, with all original components included. Borrowers are required to promptly report any malfunction, damage, or loss—regardless



of cause—to library staff. Borrowers should not attempt to repair damaged items themselves or permit repairs by anyone other than library personnel.
